



Inclusive and rights-based approaches in **Disaster data monitoring and reporting**

Sex-age-disability-disaggregated (SADD) data is fundamental for risk-informed decision-making, as it captures and differentiates between the degree and nature of the impacts of catastrophes on people with varying backgrounds.

Asian Disaster Preparedness Center (ADPC) and partners are supporting Nepal and the Philippines with regard to the implementation of the Sendai Framework Monitoring System (SFM) to better capture disaster loss and damage data, and progress reporting against the seven Sendai Framework targets.

The program seeks to create opportunities to streamline disaster-related data and support in reporting current risk reduction status that integrates gender and rights-based approaches.

Disaster data monitoring through the prism of gender and rights-based approaches will strengthen disaster risk governance and create coherence among relevant global frameworks.

Key activities



Enhancing the capacity of the system for the collection and utilization of disaster-related disaggregated data



Improving the collection and utilization of sex-age-disability-disaggregated data for DRR planning and reporting



Enhancing capacity on improving the effectiveness of reporting to the Sendai Framework Monitoring system

'Improving disaster-related data and progress reporting' is one of the key areas of the program 'Building Resilience through Inclusive and Climate-Adaptive Disaster Risk Reduction in Asia-Pacific (BRDR 2018-2022)'. BRDR puts gender-equal, rights-based, and inclusive approaches at the heart of building resilience and strengthening regional cooperation on disaster risk reduction.

Progress updates

A working guide has been developed, which integrates gender-equal and rights-based reporting on disaster loss and damage data. Furthermore, a mechanism for DRR progress reporting of the Sendai Framework targets has also been developed.

This guide will be utilized to support the improvement of country-level processes, methodologies, and development of guidelines for collecting, analyzing, storing, accessing, and utilizing the data reported under the SFM.
